## Medical Waste Support Program Application



This confidential application is for City of Saint John residents who receive solid waste collection from the City and who need additional garbage bag tags due to a medical condition that produces excess solid waste that cannot be recycled or fit within the required garbage limits. Residents must currently receive solid waste collection from the City (buildings of four units or less).

You must apply annually. If your application is approved, you will receive four (4) sheets of garbage bag tags (13 tags per sheet for a total of 52 tags) each year from the date that your application is approved. This is equal to an extra bag of garbage each week. This is in addition to the bags you are currently allowed under the Waste Wise program. Tags will be mailed to your residence. The City of Saint John will not be held responsible for tags delayed, stolen or lost in the mail.

Please note: if there are multiple residents who live in the household requiring extra tags, a separate form must be filled out for each resident.

## **Agreement, Terms, and Conditions**

I

ack	nowledge the following (please check):
	That this exemption is only required for medical waste that cannot be disposed within the bag limits as set out by the City of Saint John in its Waste Wise program. Only non-hazardous medical waste such as dialysis tubing, catheters, adult incontinence products, medical and first aid supplies can be set out for curbside collection.
	That Household Hazardous Waste such as sharps, needles, syringes, and lancets are to be placed into an approved sharp container and dropped off at a local participating pharmacy. There is no curbside collection for these items.
	That the garbage tags cannot be used by anyone else other than the resident listed above. They cannot be transferred or sold. I will only place non-hazardous medical waste in a bag which is affixed with a tag supplied through this program.
	That if the exemption is no longer required, I will notify the City of Saint John and return any remaining tags.
	That I will notify the City of Saint John if I move.
	That the City's blue bin recycling, compost, and leaf and yard waste programs are mandatory, and I will ensure all efforts are being made to divert as much waste as possible using these programs.
	That once all the additional garbage tags provided have been used for the year, I understand that I will not be provided additional tags until I reapply to the program on the anniversary date of the application.
	I understand that medical verification is required every five years.
	That I understand that the City may change the garbage limits and other curbside collection requirements, as well as the terms of the Medical Waste Support Program.
