



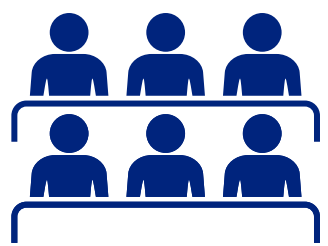

SJEMO participated in a number of exercises ranging from a nuclear radiation event to a security threat.

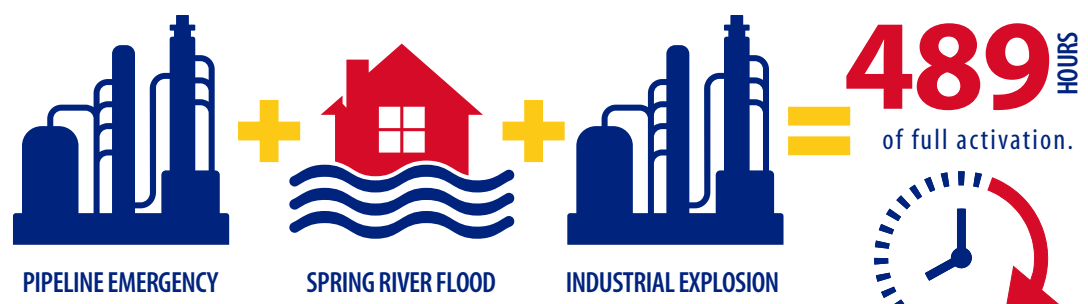
